PROPOSING FACULTY/SCHOOL	The Faculty of Engineering
TITLE OF THE OF AWARD	The Paterson Scholarships
NATURE AND VALUE OF THE AWARD	One scholarship will be awarded each year, and will support each student through the normal period of their selected course in the Faculty of Engineering. The annual value of each scholarship per student will be up to 20% of the net annual income.

PERIOD FOR WHICH AWARD IS COMMITTED <i>(a minimum of five years is required)</i>	In perpetuity commencing in 1 st semester 2007
ELIGIBILITY <i>(i.e. the cohort from which the student will be selected to win the award, e.g course/year/subject)</i>	All students entering the first year of an undergraduate degree in the Faculty of Engineering who are Australian citizens.

SELECTION CRITERIA <i>(i.e. what does the student have to do/achieve to win the award, e.g. be placed first overall in the subject ...)</i>	<p>Written applications will be shortlisted to 6 by the Scholarships Officer from the Faculty Office and the Assistant Dean (Undergraduate). Final selection will be based on application and interview. The selection panel will consists of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The Dean of Engineering (or his/her representative)• Assistant Dean (Undergraduate)• A representative from the Paterson Family• The Scholarships Officer <p>The selection criteria, in order of priority, for the scholarship are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Financial need - as determined by information provided by the applicant.• Disadvantage – as defined by the University's Access Melbourne Scheme or its successor.• Academic Merit – as determined by the student's results in the final year of secondary school.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

The Selection Committee reserves the right to not award the scholarship in any given year if no suitable candidate is identified. Any income unexpended may be added to the capital fund.

Recipients of the scholarships are expected to meet the requirements of the program in the normal period. Those who do not meet these requirements may have their scholarship withdrawn upon review by the Faculty.

In the first 3 years of the scholarship, the unused portion of the income will be added to the capital of the fund.
