Prizes already exist for the students placed first and second.</p> <p>Process is the same as the RACGP Victoria Faculty Prize (awarded to the student placed second overall in the General Practice component of <i>Integrated Clinical Practice</i>) and Victorian Metropolitan Alliance Prize in General Practice (awarded to the student placed first overall in the General Practice component of <i>Integrated Clinical Practice</i>)</p>
SPECIAL CONDITIONS	The Selection Committee (Department of General Practice) reserves the right to interview a selection of nominated students if the above criteria fail to determine a clear winner.
