Professor Kenneth Hinchcliff

Professor Kenneth Hinchcliff joins the University from the Galbreath Equine Hospital at Ohio State University where he is Head of the Section of Equine Medicine & Surgery. He has a wealth of experience as an academic, including teaching, providing clinical services, research, overseeing graduate students and as an author.

Professor Hinchcliff graduated from the University of Melbourne in 1980 with a Bachelor of Veterinary Science, obtaining a Master of Science from the University of Wisconsin-Madison in 1987 and a PhD from Ohio State University in 1990.

His area of research is in the area of equine, canine and human exercise physiology and equine medicine. He has been the lead author of a number of textbooks and has published over 150 peer-reviewed papers with a record of consistent publication in high impact journals in veterinary science and biomedical science.

Professor Hinchcliff served at Ohio State University in a variety of roles from 1987, being appointed Professor in 2000. He was a visiting scientist at Deakin University in 1998.
