<b>PROPOSING FACULTY/SCHOOL</b>	Faculty of Economics & Commerce
<b>TITLE OF THE OF AWARD</b>	Protiviti Prize for Information Processes and Controls
<b>NATURE AND VALUE OF THE AWARD</b>	\$500 per annum
<b>SPONSOR/DONOR</b>	Protiviti Directly sponsored – no regulation governing the award.
<b>PERIOD FOR WHICH AWARD IS COMMITTED</b>	5 years commencing in 2008. To be reviewed at the end of this period.
<b>ELIGIBILITY</b>	Student must be a Faculty of Economics and Commerce student, enrolled in 306-662 Information Processes and Controls, or an equivalent subject as determined by the Dean. The student must be attempting the subject for the first time.
<b>SELECTION CRITERIA</b>	The recipient shall be the student placed first overall in the subject 306-662 Information Processes and Controls. If more than student is ranked first overall, the prize will be shared.
<b>SPECIAL CONDITIONS</b>	Study Abroad and Exchange students are not eligible for the award.
