<b>SELECTION CRITERIA</b> <i>(i.e. what does the student have to do/achieve to win the award, e.g. be placed first overall in the subject ...)</i>	<p>Submit an essay or case study, based on a student/patient experience, that reflects on the use, benefits, limitations and current understanding of pathology in the diagnosis, management and study of the disease(s) of the case studied (4000 word maximum).</p> <p>The best two essays/case studies will be selected by a panel consisting of a representative of the dean of the Rural Clinical School (Chair of Panel), 2 nominees (pathologists) from Dorevitch Pathology Symbion Health, and, where considered necessary, advice from a specialist of the specialty areas of the case submitted. Where the above selection panel does not contain a majority of people with an appointment at the University of Melbourne (paid or honorary), a majority will be achieved by the Chair having a casting vote or, if necessary, sufficient additional academic staff from the Rural Clinical School will be appointed to the selection panel to achieve a university majority.</p>
