<b>PROPOSING FACULTY/SCHOOL</b>	Law
<b>TITLE OF THE AWARD</b>	Graham Hill Taxation Law Prize
<b>NATURE AND VALUE OF THE AWARD</b>	Annual Award of \$600
<b>SPONSOR/DONOR</b>	In 2004 Professor Tony Pagone QC donated \$3,000 toward an annual prize for at least the next three years to one student selected by the Director of Studies in the Post Graduate Taxation program.
<b>PERIOD FOR WHICH AWARD IS COMMITTED</b>	Five Years (Academic Years 2005 – 2009 inclusive) (or 2006-2010)
<b>ELIGIBILITY</b>	<p>Students must have completed 2 or more subjects from the graduate taxation program in the academic year under consideration.</p> <p>Students must have obtained an H1 in at least 1 subject.</p>
<b>SELECTION CRITERIA</b>	If more than one eligible student has obtained an H1 in at least 1 subject, the prize goes to the eligible student with the highest average mark for the tax subjects undertaken in that academic year.
<b>SPECIAL CONDITIONS</b>	Nil
