1. Faculty sponsoring the proposal:

Faculty of Architecture, Building and Planning

2. Title of award:

The Ledger Prize in Urban Planning

3. Nature and Value of award:

Determined annually, currently \$2,000

4. Donor:

The Ledger Fund, established in honour of Professor Frederick William Ledger, foundation Professor of Town and Regional Planning

5. Period of Commitment by Donor:

The fund will exist in perpetuity and will offer an annual undergraduate student prize.

6. Eligibility:

Full-time undergraduate final year student in the BUPD course.

7. Criteria for Selection

The prize is for the top graduating student in Urban Planning obtaining the highest aggregate results over all years of study in the Bachelor of Urban Planning and Development (BUPD) degree course. At the time of award the student will be an undergraduate student enrolled full-time in the BUPD course.
