Postgraduate Diploma in Arts (Japanese) – 100 credit points

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criterion –

- an undergraduate degree with a major (112.5 credit points) in Japanese or a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B 70% in the major, or equivalent.

2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews or tests and may call for referee reports and employer references to elucidate any of the matters referred to above.

Postgraduate Diploma in Arts (Arabic) – 100 credit points

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criterion –

- an undergraduate degree with a major (112.5 credit points) in Arabic or a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B 70% in the major, or equivalent.

Postgraduate Diploma in Arts (Chinese) – 100 credit points

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criterion –

- an undergraduate degree with a major (112.5 credit points) in Chinese or a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B 70% in the major, or equivalent.

2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews or tests and may call for referee reports and employer references to elucidate any of the matters referred to above.

Postgraduate Diploma in Arts (Islamic Studies) – 100 credit points

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criterion –

- an undergraduate degree with a major (100 points) in Islamic Studies or a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B 70% in the major, or equivalent.

2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews or tests and may call for referee reports and employer references to elucidate any of the matters referred to above.

Postgraduate Diploma in Arts (Art History) – 100 credit points

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criterion –

- an undergraduate degree with a major (100 credit points) in Art History or a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B 70% in the major, or equivalent.

2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews or tests and may call for referee reports and employer references to elucidate any of the matters referred to above.

Postgraduate Diploma in Arts Management – 100 credit points

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criterion –

- an undergraduate degree with at least 50 credit points at second or third year level in a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B 70% in these subjects , or equivalent; or
- an undergraduate degree with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) and at least one year of full time documented relevant work experience, or equivalent; or
- an undergraduate degree and a Graduate Certificate in a cognate discipline with at least H2B (70%), or equivalent.

For the 150 point program

- an undergraduate degree in a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the relevant subjects and at least one year of documented relevant work experience, or equivalent.

For the 100 point program

- an honours degree in Criminology or a cognate discipline with at least H2B (70%) or equivalent; or
- a postgraduate diploma in Criminology or a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) or equivalent; or
- an undergraduate degree in a cognate discipline, or subsequent additional qualification, (e.g. professional certificates) with a grade average grade of at least H2B (70%) in the relevant subjects and two years of full time documented relevant work experience, or equivalent.

- an undergraduate degree in a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the relevant subjects and at least two years of full time documented relevant work experience, or equivalent.

- an undergraduate degree in any field with at least a grade average of at least H2B (70%) and at least two years of full time documented relevant work experience in public or community sectors, or equivalent.

For the 150 point program

- an undergraduate degree with a major area of study related to public policy with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the relevant subjects and at least one year of documented relevant professional work experience or training, or equivalent.

For the 100 point program

- an honours degree or postgraduate diploma in a major area of study related to public policy with a research component and with at least a H2B (70%) in the relevant subjects, or equivalent; or
- an undergraduate degree in a major area of study related to public policy with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the relevant subjects and at least two years of full time documented relevant professional work experience, or equivalent.

2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews or tests and may call for referee reports and employer references to elucidate any of the matters referred to above.

Master of Social Policy

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria –

For the 200 point program

- an undergraduate degree with a major area of study related to social policy with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the relevant subjects, or equivalent; or
- an undergraduate degree in any field with an overall grade average of at least H2B (70%) and at least one year of full time documented relevant professional work experience, or equivalent.

For the 100-point program:

- an honours degree with a major area of study related to social policy with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the relevant subjects, or equivalent; or
- an undergraduate degree in any field and at least two years of full time documented relevant professional work experience, or equivalent.

2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews or tests and may call for referee reports and employer references to elucidate any of the matters referred to above.

Master of International Studies

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria –

For the 200 point program

- an undergraduate degree in a cognate discipline with policy studies with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the relevant subjects, or equivalent.

For the 150 point program

- an undergraduate degree in a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the relevant subjects and at least one year of full time documented relevant work experience, or equivalent.

For the 100 point program

- an honours degree in a cognate discipline with at least a H2B (70%), or equivalent; or
- an undergraduate degree in a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the relevant subjects and at least two years of full time documented relevant work experience, or equivalent; or
- a Postgraduate Diploma in International Studies with a grade average of at least a H2B (70%), or equivalent.

- an honours degree in a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the relevant subjects, or equivalent; or
- an undergraduate degree in a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the relevant subjects and at least two years of full time documented relevant work experience, such as research, writing, publishing or teaching in Islamic Studies, or equivalent.

2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews or tests and may call for referee reports and employer references to elucidate any of the matters referred to above.

Master of Development Studies

Master of Development Studies (Gender and Development)

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria –

For the 200 point program

- an undergraduate degree in a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the relevant subjects, or equivalent; or
- an undergraduate degree in any discipline and a Graduate Certificate in a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the relevant subjects, or equivalent; or
- an undergraduate degree in any discipline and two years of full time documented relevant work experience, or equivalent.

For the 150 point program

- an undergraduate degree in a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the relevant subjects and at least one year of full time documented relevant work experience, or equivalent; or
- an undergraduate degree in any discipline and a Graduate Diploma in a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the relevant subjects and at least one year of full time documented relevant work experience, or equivalent.

For the 100 point program

- an honours degree in development studies/gender studies or a cognate discipline with a research component with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) or equivalent; or
- an undergraduate degree in development studies/gender studies or a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the relevant subjects and at least two years of full time documented relevant professional work experience.

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria –

For the 200 point program

- an undergraduate degree in arts, creative arts and/or business including at least 50 credit points at second year level or above in subjects requiring written and analytical assessment with an overall grade average of at least H2B (70%) or equivalent; or
- an undergraduate degree with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) and at least one year of documented relevant work experience, or equivalent; or
- an undergraduate degree and a Graduate Certificate in Arts Management with a grade average of at least H2B (70%), or equivalent.

For the 100 point program

- an honours degree in a cognate discipline with at least H2B (70%), or equivalent; or
- a postgraduate diploma in a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) or equivalent; or
- an undergraduate degree in a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the relevant subjects and 2 years of full time documented relevant work experience, or equivalent.

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria

For the 200 point program

- an undergraduate degree with at least 50 credit points in Art History at second year level or above with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the relevant subject, or equivalent; or
- an undergraduate degree in a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the relevant subjects or equivalent; or
- an undergraduate degree and at least one year of documented relevant work experience, or equivalent.

For the 100 point program

- an honours degree or a postgraduate diploma in Art History or a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) or equivalent; or
- an undergraduate degree in a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the relevant subjects and 2 years of full time documented relevant work experience, or equivalent.

2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews or tests and may call for referee reports and employer references to elucidate any of the matters referred to above.

Master of Cinema Management

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria –

For the 200 point program

- an undergraduate degree with a major (100 credit points) in cinema studies or a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) over the major, or equivalent.

For the 100 point program

- an honours degree in cinema studies or a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) or equivalent; or
- an undergraduate degree in a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the relevant subjects and at least two years of full time documented relevant work experience, or equivalent.

2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews or tests and may call for referee reports and employer references to elucidate any of the matters referred to above.

Master of Publishing and Communication

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria –

For the 200 point program

- an undergraduate degree in a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) over the relevant subjects or equivalent.

For the 150 point program

- an undergraduate degree in a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the relevant subjects , and the Postgraduate Certificate in Arts (Editing and Communications); or equivalent;
- an undergraduate degree in a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the relevant subjects and one year of documented, relevant work experience, or equivalent; or
- an honours degree in a cognate discipline with at least H2B (70%), or equivalent.

For the 100 point program

- the Postgraduate Diploma in Arts (Editing and Communications) with a grade average of at least a H2B (70%) grade average; or
- an undergraduate degree in a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the relevant subjects, and the Postgraduate Certificate in Arts (Editing and Communications) with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) and at least one year's documented, relevant work experience, or equivalent; or
- an undergraduate degree in a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the relevant subjects and two years (full-time equivalent) of documented relevant professional experience.

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria –

For the 100 point program

- an honours degree in a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) or equivalent; or
- an undergraduate degree in a cognate discipline with an overall average grade of at least H2B (70%) over the relevant subjects and two years of full time documented relevant work experience, or equivalent.

2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews or tests and may call for referee reports and employer references to elucidate any of the matters referred to above.

Master of Cultural Material Conservation

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria –

For the 200 point program:

- an undergraduate degree in a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the relevant subjects, or equivalent.

For the 150 point program:

- an undergraduate degree in a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the relevant subjects and at least one year of full time documented relevant work experience, or equivalent.

For the 100 point program:

- an honours degree in a cognate discipline with at least a H2B (70%), or equivalent; or
- an undergraduate degree in a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the relevant subjects and at least two years of full time documented relevant work experience, or equivalent.

Completion of study equivalent to 25 points of university level chemistry would be considered an advantage. Applicants may be required to show evidence of manual dexterity either through a folio presentation or by reference and may be required to submit the results of a colour vision test at the time of application.

Postgraduate Diploma in Arts (Japanese) – 100 credit points

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criterion –

- an undergraduate degree with a major in Japanese (100 credit points) or the beginners' stream Japanese (125 credit points) or a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B 70% in the major, or equivalent;

2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews or tests and may call for referee reports and employer references to elucidate any of the matters referred to above.

Postgraduate Diploma in Arts (Arabic) – 100 credit points

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criterion –

- an undergraduate degree with a major in Arabic (100 credit points) or a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B 70% in the major, or equivalent;

2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews or tests and may call for referee reports and employer references to elucidate any of the matters referred to above.

Postgraduate Diploma in Arts (Chinese) – 100 credit points

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criterion –

- an undergraduate degree with a major in Chinese (100 credit points) or the beginners' stream Chinese (125 credit points) or a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B 70% in the major, or equivalent;
