**2. Title of Prize**

Megan Klemm Postgraduate Research Award

**3. Nature and Value of the Award**

The award is made to support a research postgraduate student in the School of Botany. The value of the Award will be the net annual income of the Endowment Fund held in the School of Botany Foundation.

**4. Donor**

The inaugural donation was made by Dr Bruce Underwood from the Estate of the late Megan Klemm to the School of Botany Foundation. Further donations will be sought through the School of Botany Foundation.

**5. Period of Commitment by Donor**

Each year commencing in 2003.

**6. Eligibility**

A student enrolled in a full time or part time postgraduate degree by research in the School of Botany.

**7. Criteria for Selection**

The prize will be awarded by a selection committee made up of staff from the School of Botany and chaired by the Head of the School of Botany on the basis of excellent academic achievement, to a student who is studying in the field of Botany.

The financial needs of the student may be taken into account at the discretion of the selection committee in order to encourage a worthy student.
