**1. Faculty sponsoring the proposal:**

The Faculty of Engineering

**2. Title of Prize:**

The Marconi Medal - The prize is named after Guglielmo Marconi (1874-1937) who is known as the father of modern communications because of the impact of his pioneering work in wireless telegraphy and radio transmission. Among his many honours and awards, Marconi shared the 1909 Nobel Prize in Physics with Karl Ferdinand Braun.

**3. Value of Prize:**

\$1000

**4. Donor:**

Department of Electrical & Electronic Engineering

**5. Period of Commitment by Donor:**

To be awarded twice a year for five years commencing in 2004.

**6. Eligibility:**

The prize will be open to all students enrolled in the Master of Telecommunications Engineering. As the course has two intakes each year, one prize will be awarded for each intake of students undertaking the course each year.

**7. Selection Process:**

Each prize will be awarded to the student who has the highest aggregate mark at the end of the course. Selection will take place at the completion of each of the two Master of Telecommunications Engineering programs offered each year. Selection will be based on academic results as determined by the Head of the Department of Electrical & Electronic Engineering according to the above criteria.
