<b>PROPOSING FACULTY/SCHOOL</b>	Faculty of Medicine, Dentistry & Health Sciences – School of Behavioural Science
<b>TITLE OF THE AWARD</b>	The Norma Grieve Prize
<b>NATURE AND VALUE OF THE AWARD</b>	Awarded annually, \$200
<b>SPONSOR/DONOR</b>	School of Behavioural Science
<b>PERIOD FOR WHICH AWARD IS COMMITTED</b>	Ongoing (to be reviewed after 5 years)
<b>ELIGIBILITY</b>	Students enrolled in fourth year thesis project (512-428) in psychology program [BA(Hons), BSc(Hons) or PGDip]
<b>SELECTION CRITERIA/PROCESS</b>	Awarded to the student whose thesis: a) addresses “how individuals’ thinking and behaviour are moulded by their social and cultural milieu, how they may influence this context, and/or how individuals with psychological difficulties can be assisted to participate fully in society”, b) receives the highest mark, and c) is of at least H2A standard. Satisfaction of criterion a) is to be judged by a panel of three academic staff members
