

**PROPOSAL FOR NEW STUDENT AWARD**

**The University of Melbourne Land and Food Resources Bursaries**

**1. Faculty Sponsoring the Proposal:**

Faculty of Land and Food Resources.

**2. Title of Scholarship:**

The University of Melbourne Land and Food Resources Bursaries

**3. Value of the Bursary:**

\$2500 per year, to fully or partially reduce or waive tuition or course fees and /or board and lodging charges at LFR regional campuses.

**4. Donor:**

The University of Melbourne.

**5. Period of Commitment by Donor:**

Available for 2005 and 2006 in the first instance.

**6. Eligibility:**

Commencing students must be enrolled full-time on-campus in one of the Faculty's Diploma or Advanced Diploma Higher Education or TAFE courses (or a full time course leading to those qualifications) and whose home residence is more than 80 kilometres (based on home postcode) from the regional campus that they are attending, either Longerenong, Glenormiston, McMillan, Dookie, or Creswick.

**7. Criteria for Selection:**

Selection will be based principally on academic merit, but consideration for special circumstances may be taken into account using criteria including relevant work experience, and this will be assessed by a scholarship committee of the faculty. All students who have applied for relevant courses will be considered for bursaries.

**8. Special Conditions:**

A total of 100 bursaries will be available annually and a minimum number of bursaries will be available for students studying at each of Longerenong, Glenormiston, McMillan, Dookie, and Creswick.

**9. Other:**

To continue to receive the bursary in the subsequent year, students will be required to make satisfactory progress toward the completion of their award.
