ELIGIBILITY	The Chinese Lions Club Scholarship will be available to students enrolled in the in the Intensive Chinese Program 110-226 within the year in which the scholarship is to be awarded.
SELECTION CRITERIA	<p>The Selection Committee will consist of three Academic staff from the Chinese program area. The Selection Committee will determine the successful applicant based on the following selection criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applicants must have successfully completed either : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Introduction to Chinese 2B (110029) and Spoken Introduction to Chinese 2B (110030) OR Chinese 1B (110161) • Applicants must be a currently enrolled diploma or degree student at the University of Melbourne and an Australian citizen or Permanent Resident. • Selection will be based on a combination of academic merit and community involvement. • Preference will be given to students who had not previously had an opportunity to study in China.
