

ACADEMIC BOARD RESOLUTIONS ON SELECTION

Faculty of Arts

Master of Arts (Asian Societies) - 200, 150 and 100 credit point programs

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria –

200 credit points

- Undergraduate degree with a major in Asian Studies with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the major or equivalent; or
- A Graduate Diploma in Arts (Asian Studies) with a grade average of H2B (70%) or equivalent.

150 credit points.

- Undergraduate degree in a relevant discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the major, or equivalent and at least one year of documented, relevant, work experience.

100 credit points

- An honours degree in Asian Studies or a cognate discipline with at least a H2B grade; or
- An honours degree in any discipline with at least 3 years full time documented, relevant, work experience.

2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews, call for written work, referee reports and employer references to elucidate any matters to do with selection.

Master of Arts (Gender and Development) - 200, 150 and 100 credit point programs

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria –

200 credit points

- Undergraduate degree with a major in gender studies or a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the major or equivalent; or
- A Graduate Certificate in gender studies with a grade average of H2B (70%) or equivalent.

150 credit points.

- Undergraduate degree with a major in gender studies or a cognate discipline with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) in the major, or equivalent and at least one year of documented, relevant, work experience or training in research and/or policy and administration in areas such as education, the public service, social work, publishing, business and management, women's services health and law.

100 credit points

- A four year honours degree with a thesis in gender studies with a grade average of at least H2B (70%); or
- A postgraduate diploma in a relevant area with a grade average of at least H2B (70%); or

- A postgraduate certificate in a relevant area with a grade average of at least H2B (70%) and one year of documented, relevant, work experience.
2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews, call for written work, referee reports and employer references to elucidate any matters to do with selection.

Graduate Certificate in Criminology (Forensic Disability) – 50 credit points

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria –
 - Undergraduate degree or equivalent in any discipline; or
 - at least 5 years of documented, relevant, professional experience.
2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews, call for written work, referee reports and employer references to elucidate any matters to do with selection.

Faculty of Engineering

Joint Bachelor of Engineering program between University of Melbourne and the National University of Singapore – 400 credit points

The entry requirements are those specified for the Bachelor of Engineering. The course need not be listed in the Principles as the entry requirements for first year are the same.

Faculty of Land and Food Resources

Master of Agribusiness – 150 credit points

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criterion –
 - Undergraduate degree with honours in an appropriate discipline and at least two years of documented, relevant, work or management experience.
2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews, call for written work, referee reports and employer references to elucidate any matters to do with selection.

Faculty of Medicine, Dentistry and Health Sciences

Master of Epidemiology - 100 credit points

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria –
 - An Honours degree in a relevant discipline with at least H2B (70%) in the major, or equivalent; or
 - A medical degree; or
 - A postgraduate diploma in Epidemiology with at least H2B (70%) average, or equivalent; or
 - A degree in a relevant discipline with at least H2B (70%) average in the major and at least 2 years of relevant, documented full-time work experience.
2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews and tests and call for referee reports and employer references to elucidate any matters to do with selection.

Faculty of Music

Postgraduate Diploma in Music – 100 credit points

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria –
 - An undergraduate degree with a major in Music and at least an average H2B (70%) grade across the major; or
 - At least 5 years equivalent, documented, professional experience.
2. Selection into the performance or instrumental/vocal streams of the Diploma will be subject to a satisfactory audition. Selection into the composition stream of the postgraduate diploma will be subject to the satisfactory assessment of a composition folio.
3. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews, call for written work, referee reports and employer references to elucidate any matters to do with selection.

Faculty of Science

Master of Information Systems – 200, 150 and 100 credit points

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria –
 - 200 credit points
 - An undergraduate degree in Information Systems or a relevant discipline with at least an average of H3B (65%).
 - 150 credit points
 - An undergraduate degree in Information Systems or a relevant discipline with an average of at least H3B (65%) and one year of documented, relevant, work experience; or
 - An undergraduate degree in Information Systems or a relevant discipline and the Postgraduate Certificate in Information Systems with an average of at least H3B (65%) in the Postgraduate Certificate, or equivalent; or
 - An undergraduate degree in any discipline with at least an average of H3B (65%) and five years of documented relevant, work experience.
 - 100 credit points
 - A 4 year Honours degree in Information Systems with an average grade of at least H3B (65%), or equivalent; or
 - An undergraduate degree in Information Systems or a relevant discipline, one year of documented, relevant, work experience and the Postgraduate Certificate in Information Systems with an average of at least H3B (65%), or equivalent; or
 - An undergraduate degree in any discipline, five years of documented, relevant, work experience and the Postgraduate Certificate in Information Systems with an average of at least H3B (65%), or equivalent; or
 - An undergraduate degree in any discipline and the Postgraduate Diploma in Information Systems with an average of at least H3B (65%) or equivalent.
2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews, call for written work, referee reports and employer references to elucidate any matters to do with selection.

Postgraduate Certificate in Information Systems – 50 credit points

Postgraduate Diploma in Information Systems – 100 credit points

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria –
 - An undergraduate degree in Information Systems or a relevant discipline with at least an average of H3B (65%); or
 - An undergraduate degree in any discipline with at least an average of H3B (65%) and five years of documented relevant, work experience.
2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews, call for written work, referee reports and employer references to elucidate any matters to do with selection.

Victorian College of the Arts

Graduate Certificate in Visual Art – 50 credit points

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria –
 - Undergraduate degree or equivalent in any discipline; or
 - at least 5 years equivalent, documented, professional experience.
2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews, call for written work, referee reports and employer references to elucidate any matters to do with selection.
