PERIOD FOR WHICH AWARD IS COMMITTED	Five years commencing in 2006
ELIGIBILITY	<p>The prize will be available to all students undertaking the penultimate year of an Engineering degree leading towards accreditation, majoring in chemical, civil, mechanical or electrical engineering at the University of Melbourne, including those undertaking combined degrees.</p>
SELECTION CRITERIA	<p>Selection will take place in the second semester of each year. Students will be requested to submit an application to be considered for the prize.</p> <p>Applications will be judged on the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Academic excellence• Leadership skills• Teamwork• Extracurricular activities• Demonstrated initiative• Demonstrated interest in petroleum engineering and the petroleum industry <p>The Selection Committee will consist of two representatives from the Society of Petroleum Engineers and two representatives from the Faculty of Engineering who will make a recommendation to the Dean of the Faculty. The recipient may be selected by application only or by application and interview.</p>
