<b>SELECTION CRITERIA</b>	The prize is awarded to the student who achieves the highest weighted average of marks across the final 100 points of the Bachelor of Architecture, taken within a calendar year. (Weighted average = the mark for each subject multiplied by the points value of that subject, divided by 100.)
