

Academic Board Resolutions on Selection**Faculty of Arts****Master of International Politics - 200, 150 and 100 credit points**

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria -

200 credit points

- an undergraduate degree with at least H2B (70%) average, or equivalent; or
- a Graduate Diploma in Political Science from the University of Melbourne with at least H2B (70%) average, or equivalent

150 credit points

- an undergraduate degree with at least H2B (70%) average, or equivalent, and at least one year of documented, relevant, professional experience.

100 credit points

- an undergraduate degree with at least H2B (70%) average, or equivalent, and at least five years of documented, relevant, professional experience in an organisation directly involved in international politics plus evidence of significant career advancement; or
- an honours degree with at least H2B (70%) average or equivalent; or
- a Postgraduate Diploma in Political Science from the University of Melbourne with at least H2B (70%) average, or equivalent.

2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews or tests and may call for referee reports and employer references to elucidate any of the matters referred to above.

Faculty of Law**Juris Doctor – 300 credit points**

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria-

- Results on the Law Schools Admission Test (LSAT), including the essay component.
- Grade point average on the basis of all tertiary study undertaken, with all subjects weighted independently of year level or discipline.
- Personal statement by the applicant relating to personal circumstances, work and life experience.

2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews or tests or call for referee reports or employer references to elucidate any of the matters referred to above.

3. Students who have not obtained a university degree from an institution in which English is the language of instruction and assessment must have obtained a score of 610 or more in the American TOEFL, including an Essay rating score of 5.0 in the TWE; or a score of 253 in the computer-based TOEFL; or an overall band score of 7.0 or more in the IELTS, with a minimum band score of 7.0 in the Academic Writing Module.

Guaranteed Pathways into the Juris Doctor for school leavers.

Students with sufficiently high ENTER may be offered a guaranteed pathway into the Juris Doctor subject to successful completion of a University of Melbourne undergraduate degree at an average of at least H2A (75%).

- For a full fee place, the required ENTER is 99.0.
- For a Commonwealth-Supported Place, the required ENTER is 99.9.
