ELIGIBILITY	Students may be nominated by Clinical teachers or peers for consideration. Nominees must be in good academic standing.
SELECTION CRITERIA	<p>Awarded to the RCS student who best demonstrates professionalism as a duty of care for patients, colleagues and self as judged by a Committee including the Head of School, Clinical Dean, Rural Clinical School Sub-Deans, Rural Clinical School Administration staff, a Community Advisory Board Member and one designated person from each Hospital (Goulburn Valley Health, Ballarat Health Services and North East Health Wangaratta).</p> <p>Nominations will be taken from clinical teachers and peers</p> <p>Demonstrate outstanding professionalism including in duty of care for patients, colleagues, and self. Be recognised as a role model and an empathetic, excellent future doctor and colleague.</p> <p>Student must have outstanding attendance and participation record and excellent tutor evaluations.</p> <p>Students must give written authority for extracts from their student files relevant to the selection criteria only, to be provided to the non-University members of the selection committee</p> <p>The committee will make final recommendations to the Dean based on review of up to 2 letters of support, comments from student files, the nominee's academic records and a CV if appropriate.</p>
