

ACADEMIC BOARD RESOLUTIONS ON SELECTION

School of Dental Science - Postgraduate Courses

Doctor of Clinical Dentistry - 300 credit points

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria-
 - an undergraduate degree in Dentistry and at least two years of documented continuous clinical work experience;
 - for international students an IELTS score of 7.0 overall and a minimum of 7.0 in writing or the equivalent TOEFL scores.
2. The Selection Committee may call for referee reports and employer references to assist in the selection process.

Doctor of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery - 300 credit points

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria-
 - an undergraduate degree in Dentistry or Medicine and a Postgraduate Diploma in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery from the University of Melbourne; and
 - two years or equivalent, of documented clinical work experience following graduation; and
 - a pass in the primary fellowship examination of a dental college or equivalent from a surgical college; and
 - eligibility for full registration as either a dentist or medical practitioner in the State of Victoria;
 - for international students an IELTS score of 7.0 overall and a minimum of 7.0 in writing or the equivalent TOEFL scores.
2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews or tests or call for referee reports or employer references to elucidate any of the matters above.

Postgraduate Diploma in Clinical Dentistry - 100 credit points

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria-
 - an undergraduate degree in Dentistry; and
 - two years relevant full time, or equivalent, documented clinical work experience;
 - for international students an IELTS score of 7.0 overall and a minimum of 7.0 in writing or the equivalent TOEFL scores.
2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews or tests and call for referee reports or employer references to elucidate any of the matters referred to above.

Postgraduate Diploma in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery - 100 credit points

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria-
 - an undergraduate degree in Dentistry or Medicine and,
 - two years of documented clinical work experience, following graduation, or equivalent; and
 - a pass in the primary fellowship examination of a dental college or equivalent from a surgical college and
 - eligibility for full registration as either a dentist or medical practitioner in the State of Victoria;
 - for international students an IELTS score of 7.0 overall and a minimum of 7.0 in writing or the equivalent TOEFL scores.
2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews or tests or call for referee reports or employer references to elucidate any of the matters above.

Graduate Diploma in Forensic Odontology - 100 credit points

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criterion-
 - an undergraduate degree;
 - for international students an IELTS score of 7.0 overall and a minimum of 7.0 in writing or the equivalent TOEFL scores.
2. The Selection Committee may call conduct interviews or tests or call for referee reports or employer references to elucidate any of the matters above.
