

5. Victorian College of the Arts

Bachelor of Music Theatre - 300 points

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria:

- VCE Units 3 and 4 - a study score of at least 25 in English (any); and,
- Successful completion of an audition.

2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews or tests and may call for referee reports to elucidate any of the matters referred to above.

Note: The audition will test the following:

- The applicant's standard of performance knowledge of Music Theatre repertoire in regards to voice and singing
- ability to dance with an appropriate level of technical skill and coordination
- ability to act with an appropriate degree of insight into character and script analysis
- knowledge of music theory.

In exceptional cases of demonstrated artistic talent the academic requirements may be waived, although students will be expected to have successfully completed VCE English or equivalent.

Master of Theatre Practice

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criterion-

- A Postgraduate Diploma in Performance Creation with average grade of at least H2B (70%) and a grade of H1 (80%) in project work, or equivalent.

2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews or tests and may call for referee reports and employer references to elucidate any of the matters referred to above.

Bachelor of Production (Honours)

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria-

- A Bachelor of Production with a grade of at least H2B in final year practical work, or equivalent

2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews or tests and may call for referee reports and employer references to elucidate any of the matters referred to above.

Master of Production

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criterion -

- Either a Postgraduate Diploma in Production with average grade of at least H2B (70%) and a grade of H1 (80%) in project work, or equivalent, or at least five years of documented relevant professional experience.

2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews or tests and may call for referee reports and employer references to elucidate any of the matters referred to above.

Postgraduate Diploma in Dance Science

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria:

- an undergraduate degree with a major in a relevant discipline (dance, movement sciences, or health practices such as physiotherapy, chiropractic, massage therapy, podiatry, sports medicine, osteopathy, nutrition, sport or performance psychology) or equivalent; or
- at least five years of documented professional experience in relevant areas such as dance performance, dance teaching, dance administration, choreography, pilates instruction, fitness or personal training, yoga or martial arts.

2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews for short-listed applicants and may call for referee reports and employer references to elucidate any of the matters referred to above.
