TITLE OF THE OF AWARD	Goulburn Valley Imaging Rural Travel Fellowship to travel to University of Washington to complete elective
NATURE AND VALUE OF THE AWARD	Award Value: two awards of up to \$2500 each year (depending on funding)
SPONSOR/DONOR	Goulburn Valley Imaging
PERIOD FOR WHICH AWARD IS COMMITTED	Annual renewal Note: this prize is of significant value (\$5,000 per annum) and therefore a decision to award will be made annually by the donor who is unable to make a 5-year commitment.
ELIGIBILITY	Students may nominate themselves by written application. The award will be subject to elective approval at the University of Washington.
SELECTION CRITERIA	<p>Awarded to the student who best demonstrates professionalism as a duty of care for patients, colleagues and self as judged by a Committee including the Clinical Dean, Rural Clinical School Sub-Deans, a Community Advisory Board Member and the School Manager</p> <p>Nominations will be taken by written application Student must have outstanding attendance and participation record and excellent tutor evaluations. Preference will be given to students in the top half of Semester 8-9 performance at the Rural Clinical School. Students must give written authority for extracts from their student files relevant to the selection criteria only, to be provided to the non-University members of the selection committee The committee will make final recommendations to the Dean based on a review of up to 2 letters of support, comments from student files, the nominee's academic records and a CV if appropriate.</p>
