1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria –

Postgraduate Certificate in Educational Studies (International Baccalaureate) (PYP and DP) (50 points)

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria:
 - an appropriate honours degree in Education; or
 - an appropriate four-year degree in Education, or equivalent, and at least two years of documented relevant professional experience
2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews and tests and may call for referee reports and employer references to assist in the selection process.

Master of Education (International Baccalaureate), (Coursework) (PYP and DP) (100 points)

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria:
 - an appropriate honours degree in Education; or
 - an appropriate four-year degree in Education, or equivalent, and at least two years of documented relevant professional experience
2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews and tests and may call for referee reports and employer references to assist in the selection process.

Master of Education (International Baccalaureate), (Coursework and 20000 Word Thesis) (PYP and DP) (100 points)

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria:
 - an appropriate honours degree in Education; or
 - an appropriate four-year degree in Education, or equivalent, and at least two years of documented relevant professional experience and a record of research activity and/or publications equivalent to 50 points of year five study.
2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews and tests and may call for referee reports and employer references to assist in the selection process.

Faculty of Medicine, Dentistry and Health Sciences

Master of Women's Health (100 points)

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria:
 - an undergraduate degree in medicine;
 - a 3 year undergraduate degree in a health related field or the social sciences, or equivalent cognate discipline and at least 50 credit points towards the Postgraduate Diploma in Women's Health with at least H2B (70%) average and one year of documented relevant work experience;
 - a four year degree in a health related field or the social sciences, or equivalent.
2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews and tests and may call for referee reports and employer references to elucidate any of the matters referred to above.

Faculty of Science

Master of Information Systems (200 points)

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to successfully pursue the course using the criteria listed below:

200 credit point entry

- an undergraduate degree in any discipline with at least H3 (65%) average in the final year of study or equivalent

150 credit point entry

- an undergraduate degree in any discipline with at least H3 (65%) average in the final year of study and one year documented relevant work experience; or
- a Graduate Certificate in Information Systems with at least H3 (65%) average in the Graduate Certificate or equivalent

100 credit point entry

- a four-year Honours degree in Information Systems with at least H3 (65%) average in the final year of study or equivalent; or
- an undergraduate degree in Information Systems with at least H3 (65%) average in the final year of study or equivalent and two years documented relevant work experience; or
- an undergraduate degree in any discipline, one year of documented relevant work experience and the Postgraduate Certificate in Information Systems with at least H3 (65%) average or equivalent; or
- an undergraduate degree in any discipline and the Postgraduate Diploma in Information Systems with at least H3 (65%) average or equivalent.

2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews and tests and may call for referee reports and employer references to elucidate any of the matters referred to above.

Note: references above to a degree in Information Systems means a degree with at least 60% of specialised information systems studies, including a balanced mix of technical and management topics, project management and professional ethics.

Graduate Certificate in Information Systems (50 points)

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to successfully pursue the course using the criteria listed below:

- an undergraduate degree in any discipline with at least H3 (65%) average in the final year of study or equivalent

2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews and tests and may call for referee reports and employer references to elucidate any of the matters referred to above.

Victorian College of the Arts

Bachelor of Music Theatre (300 pts)

1. The Selection Committee will evaluate the applicant's ability to pursue successfully the course using the following criteria:

- VCE Units 3 and 4 -a study score of at least 25 in English (any); and,
- Successful completion of an audition.

2. The Selection Committee may conduct interviews or tests and may call for referee reports to elucidate any of the matters referred to above.

Note: The audition will test the following:

- The applicant's standard of performance knowledge of Music Theatre repertoire in regards to voice and singing, and
- ability to dance with an appropriate level of technical skill and coordination, and
- ability to act with an appropriate degree of insight into character and script analysis, and
- knowledge of music theory.

In exceptional cases of demonstrated artistic talent the academic requirements may be waived, although students will be expected to have successfully completed VCE English or equivalent.
