SELECTION CRITERIA	The prize shall be awarded to the student in each cohort placed first overall in the subject <i>730-530 Legal Ethics</i>
FURTHER INFORMATION	Clive Brookes was the founding partner of Monahan + Rowell, having emigrated from England via Kenya, where he was Crown Prosecutor. He understood his obligations to the court, the profession and his clients, addressing his clients without hiding behind complex correspondence so as to remember his ethical responsibilities and act accordingly. Clive Brookes passed away in 1993 whilst in active partnership with Monahan + Rowell.
