David Bruce was the first lawyer of the National Bank and founded the Legal Department which has now grown into a global group of nearly 250 staff. In the last 40 years the Bank has had only 2 General Counsels and David occupied the role for more than 30 of those years. David graduated from the University of Melbourne with a Bachelor of Laws degree in 1959.
