PROPOSING FACULTY/SCHOOL	Faculty of Arts Faculty of Economics and Commerce
TITLE OF THE OF AWARD	Australian Industrial Relations Commission Centennial Prize
NATURE AND VALUE OF THE AWARD	An annual prize is to be awarded in alternate years between the Faculty of Arts and the Faculty of Economics and Commerce. The value of the award is the Net Annual Income of a fund for which subscriptions close in July 2005.
SPONSOR/DONOR	Members of the Australian Industrial Relations Commission
PERIOD FOR WHICH AWARD IS COMMITTED	The prize shall be awarded each year commencing in 2005 in the Faculty of Economics and Commerce.
ELIGIBILITY	Faculty of Arts – current students in an honours year in a bachelor degree in Arts or in the masters by research in Arts. Faculty of Economics and Commerce - current students in an honours year in a bachelor degree in Commerce or in the Master of Commerce in Employment Relations and Human Resources Management.
SELECTION CRITERIA	The best research thesis in the field of industrial relations or labour history, on the recommendation of the respective Dean, who before making the award must consult the President of the AIRC.
