**B J Shaw Law Prize**

**1. Faculty sponsoring the proposal**

**2. Title of Prize**

B J Shaw Law Prize

**3. Value of the Prize**

\$1,000 per year

**4. Donor**

Colleagues of Brian J Shaw QC.

This prize is given by colleagues of Brian Shaw QC to mark his retirement and recognise his honourable and distinguished career at the Bar and within the legal profession.

All initial donors may be contacted near the expected date of expiration of funds for a further financial commitment to allow extension of this prize.

**5. Period of Commitment by Donor**

First awarded in 2007 with \$1,000 per annum to be awarded until funds are exhausted. At August 2007 funds for this award total \$18,000

Minimum anticipated time period for award presentation: 2007 – 2025.

**6. Eligibility**

The recipient is to be a student enrolled in a law program offered by the Faculty of Law, University of Melbourne.

**7. Criteria for Selection**

The B J Shaw Law Prize is to be awarded to the student with the highest academic score gained in the graduate subjects of Corporate Taxation (Companies and Consolidation) or Corporate Taxation (Shareholders, Debts and Equity) as offered by the Faculty of Law.
