<b>PROPOSING FACULTY/SCHOOL</b>	Faculty of Arts
<b>TITLE OF THE OF AWARD</b>	The Miltiades and Alkistis Chryssavgis Scholarship
<b>NATURE AND VALUE OF THE AWARD</b>	<p>An annual scholarship for an Indigenous student commencing 1<sup>st</sup> Year Bachelor of Arts; who is in financial need. The amount of the scholarship will be \$2,500 for 2007 and the net annual income thereafter. The Scholarship will be paid in two parts, once per semester after each HECS census date.</p> <p>A \$50,000 donation received from Reverend Father Miltiades Chryssavgis.</p>
<b>SPONSOR/DONOR</b>	<p>Reverend Father Miltiades Chryssavgis.</p> <p>This award is to be governed by a regulation</p>
<b>PERIOD FOR WHICH AWARD IS COMMITTED</b>	For perpetuity
<b>ELIGIBILITY</b>	Open for application to incoming students into the Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Art (Media & Communications) first year, who are Indigenous Australians and in financial need.
<b>SELECTION CRITERIA</b>	<p>Financial need will be assessed based on evidence of income and expenses as required on the application form by a selection committee.</p> <p>The committee will comprise: The Bachelor of Arts Selection Officer; The Prizes and Scholarships Officer in the Faculty of Arts; Associate Dean (Undergraduate Studies) Faculty of Arts; Programs Manager in the Centre for Indigenous Education; and the Scholarships Officer in the Centre for Indigenous Education.</p>
<b>SPECIAL CONDITIONS</b>	The Centre for Indigenous Education will verify Australian Indigenous status
