

## **Regulation 8.1.R6 - MELBOURNE UNIVERSITY BOOKSHOPS**

### **Interpretation**

1. In this regulation-

The Melbourne University Bookshops are referred to as **‘the bookshop’**

### **Establishment**

2. The bookshop is a department of the University operating as a semi-autonomous body with a board, pursuant to Statute 8.1.

### **Objectives**

3. The objectives of the bookshop are to:

- (a) work closely with departments to supply students with teaching and text materials to meet course and research requirements at affordable prices;
- (b) actively source information globally to provide support material for researchers, including the latest scholarly monographs and trade titles for academics and the wider community;
- (c) seek out opportunities for e-commerce including electronic publishing, publishing on demand and digital delivery;
- (d) maintain a high quality campus bookstore website and provide new services electronically as they evolve;
- (e) provide an efficient and courteous service and procure a wide range of ancillary goods and services appropriate to a campus-based business for retailing to its customers from the University and wider community;
- (f) exploit synergies with Melbourne University Publishing Limited to ensure that the University and its staff receive adequate commercial reward for their intellectual property; and
- (g) operate on a commercial basis and return a profit to the University.
