

R6.38 - JOHN CHARLES LLOYD EXHIBITION

Recitals-

- A. Charles D. Lloyd of 33 Queen Street Melbourne presented to the University the sum of \$2,000 in the form of a Commonwealth Government Debenture for the purpose of founding an exhibition or scholarship to perpetuate the name of his late father, John Charles Lloyd, and of encouraging the study of Architecture at the University.
- B. The sum of \$2,000 increased to \$4,595 at 31 December 1994.

It is provided as follows

- 1. The sum of \$4,595 and any additions and accumulations to the sum forms a fund called the "John Charles Lloyd Exhibition"("the fund), and the fund must be paid into an investment pool and remain there until the Council directs otherwise.
- 2. The net annual income of the endowment provides an exhibition which is open to competition annually among candidates pursuing the course for the degree of bachelor of Architecture.
- 3. The exhibition is awarded by the Council to the candidate who obtains the highest aggregate marks in Building Construction part II and such other related subjects as the faculty of Architecture, Building and Planning may from time to time determine.
