

R6.41 - ALWYN STEWART MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Recitals-

- A. Mr. and Mrs. Randal J. Alcock of Kooyongkoot Road Hawthorn presented to the University the sum of £1,000 in the form of Commonwealth 5% Inscribed Stock for the purpose of founding a scholarship in memory of their nephew Major Cedric Alwyn Stewart, M.D., who was killed in the First World War at Borre in France on the 28 April 1918 whilst attending to the wounds of a fellow officer.
- B. The University received £1,000 at the time of the donation, which sum increased to \$3,299 at 31 December 1994.

It is provided as follows

- 1. The sum of \$3,299 and any accumulations and additions to the sum forms a fund called the "Alwyn Stewart Memorial Scholarship" ("the fund") and the fund must be paid into an investment pool and remain there until the Council directs otherwise.
- 2. The amount of the scholarship must not exceed in value the net income of the fund.
- 3. The scholarship is open to candidates who have obtained honours at the final honours assessment in the course for the degrees of bachelor of Medicine and bachelor of Surgery and who are willing to undertake further scientific work with the object of improving their training for their profession.
