

# Astronomy

The School of Physics in the Faculty of Science offers two first year subjects in Astronomy, which may be taken as part of the Bachelor of Arts degree.

## Faculty of Arts requirements

Students undertaking the Bachelor of Arts are permitted to enrol in a range of subjects offered by other faculties, but must complete a minimum of 50 points of first year subjects in areas of study approved by the Faculty of Arts; see *Arts-approved subject requirement (p.37)* for more information.

Combined course students will not usually be eligible to enrol in these subjects as part of their Bachelor of Arts. Students should consult a Faculty of Arts course adviser for more information.
