The School of Physics in the Faculty of Science offers two first year subjects in astronomy, which may be taken as part of the Bachelor of Arts degree.

Faculty of Arts requirements

Students undertaking the Bachelor of Arts are permitted to enrol in a range of subjects offered by other faculties, but must complete a minimum of 50 points of first year subjects in areas of study approved by the Faculty of Arts; see *Arts-approved subject requirement (p.4)* for more information.

Combined course students will not usually be eligible to enrol in these subjects as part of their Bachelor of Arts. Students should consult a Faculty of Arts course adviser for more information.
