

STATUTE 1.4 - PUBLICATION OF STATUTES AND REGULATIONS

University secretary to publish statutes and regulations

- 1.4.1 The university secretary must publish all statutes and regulations in a form approved by Council accessible by such means as Council determines.

University secretary to publish standing resolutions of the Council

- 1.4.2 The university secretary must publish all standing resolutions made by Council in a form approved by Council accessible by such means as Council determines.

Academic registrar to publish student information

- 1.4.3 (1) The academic registrar must publish at least annually in a form approved either by Council or by the Board, as appropriate, handbook and other academic and student information as required by Council or the Board.
- (2) Where a statute or regulation contains academic and student information which directly affects students, the information must be provided or otherwise made available to them on enrolment and re-enrolment. A change to a statute or regulation which occurs during an academic year and which directly affects students during that academic year may be made only after an assessment of the impact of changes and provision of reasonable notice to those affected.
