

R6.136 - ERIC AND LINDA JULLYAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Recitals-

- A. Linda Jullyan, late of Toorak, who died on 24 December 1965 bequeathed to the University the sum of \$4,000 to be held in trust

"... as a scholarship in perpetuity to be known as the 'Eric and Linda Jullyan Memorial Scholarship' the annual income from which shall be applied in such manner as the Ormond Professor of Music for the time being shall determine for the use and benefit of a senior student in music studying at the Conservatorium of Music who shall be selected annually by the said Professor who shows promise worthy of development and who is in the opinion of the said Professor a fit and proper person to receive such assistance."

- B. The purposes for which the Conservatorium was established are now carried out by the faculty of Music and the name "University Conservatorium of Music" has been discontinued.
- C. The sum of \$4,000 increased to \$5,828 at 31 December 1994.

It is provided as follows

1. The sum of \$5,828 and any accumulations or additions to the sum forms a fund called the "Eric and Linda Jullyan Memorial Scholarship Fund" ("the fund") and the fund must be paid into an investment pool and remain there until the Council directs otherwise.
2. The scholarship is awarded annually by the Council to the student selected by the Ormond professor of Music ("the professor").
3. The value of the scholarship is the net annual income of the fund.
4. The tenure of the scholarship is one year, but it may be renewed for a further period of one year if the Council so determines on the recommendation of the professor.
5. The tenure of the scholarship is conditional upon the work and behaviour of the scholar being considered satisfactory by the professor.
6. The scholarship is to be awarded to a student who has completed two years of the course for the degree of bachelor of Music.
