Rob Moodie is Professor of Global Health at the Nossal Institute for Global Health at the University of Melbourne. Between 1998 and 2007 he was the CEO of VicHealth, the Victorian Health Promotion Foundation.

Since 1979 he has worked for Save the Children Fund, Medicins Sans Frontieres, Congress, the Aboriginal Health Service in Alice Springs, the Burnet Institute and for the World Health Organization, and the joint United Nations Program on HIV/AIDS (UNAIDS).

He chaired the audit of the Victorian Government's major planning blueprint for Melbourne, Melbourne 2030, and has recently taken up a new role as chair of the National Preventative Health Task Force

Rob chairs the Technical Panel to the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation's HIV prevention program in India and chairs the Melbourne Storm Rugby League Club.

He co-editor of three books, including *Hands on Health Promotion*, and has recently published *Recipes for a Great Life*, written with Gabriel Gate.

He is married to Anne, a physiotherapist, and they have two children Nick, 23 and Penny 21. He was named 2005 Victorian Father of the Year.
