

Declaration

1. Any false and misleading information shall lead to disqualification of the application and cancellation of any resulting membership status.
2. Information provided in the application form to AAUM (HK Chapter) and University of Melbourne shall become part of their alumni record and may be used for a number of communications and administrative purposes that are consistent with the mission of AAUM and University of Melbourne alumni policies.

Terms and conditions

1. Applications are subject to verification by the committee of AAUM (HK) before approval. The committee has the right to approve any membership applications.
2. Upon approval of the application, members agree to observe and be bound by the Memorandum of Association and Articles of Association and by-laws of AAUM (HK).
3. A membership year begins on 1st July each year until 30th June of the next year. Any application (except new graduates) from 1st January (inclusive) each year will be charged half-yearly membership fee.
4. Full membership status is available to alumni who have completed one (or more) of the following qualifications in the University of Melbourne:
 - (i) Undergraduate degree
 - (ii) Postgraduate degree (including Melbourne Business School)
 - (iii) Postgraduate certificate
 - (iv) Postgraduate diploma

Exchange students are also eligible for membership.

5. Associate membership status is available to those who do not meet the requirements of point 4 who are interested in participating in AAUM (HK)'s activities. Associate members are entitled to enjoy all full membership's benefits. However, associate members do not have the following rights:
 - (i) Seat or elect into the board of committee
 - (ii) Voting power of any resolutions or elections
6. Data held by AAUM (HK) relating to each applicant and member will be kept confidential subject to the terms of the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance of Hong Kong, and will be supplied to the University of Melbourne for the purposes of maintaining alumni records, under Australian Privacy Legislation.
7. Nothing under the terms and conditions of this application shall limit the rights of applicants under the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance.
