

## **UTR7.180 - IVAN NIKIFOROVICH SOOKHANOFF BEQUEST**

### **Recitals-**

- A. Ivan Nikiforovich Sookhanoff, late of East Hawthorn in the State of Victoria, who died on 17 April 1991, bequeathed to the University his residuary estate "to be used in the promotion of medical or scientific research into the cause of cancer".
- B. The University received \$99,520 in satisfaction of the bequest, which sum increased to \$227,581 at 31 December 1994.

It is provided as follows-

- 1. The sum of \$227,581 and any accumulations and additions to the sum forms a fund called the "Ivan Nikiforovich Sookhanoff Bequest" ("the fund") and the fund must be paid into an investment pool and remain there until the Council directs otherwise.
- 2. The net annual income of the fund must be applied by the Council to medical or scientific research into the cause of cancer on the recommendation of the faculty of Medicine, Dentistry and Health Sciences ("the faculty").
- 3. The Council may, on the recommendation of the faculty, direct that the capital of the fund be resorted to for the purpose referred to above.
