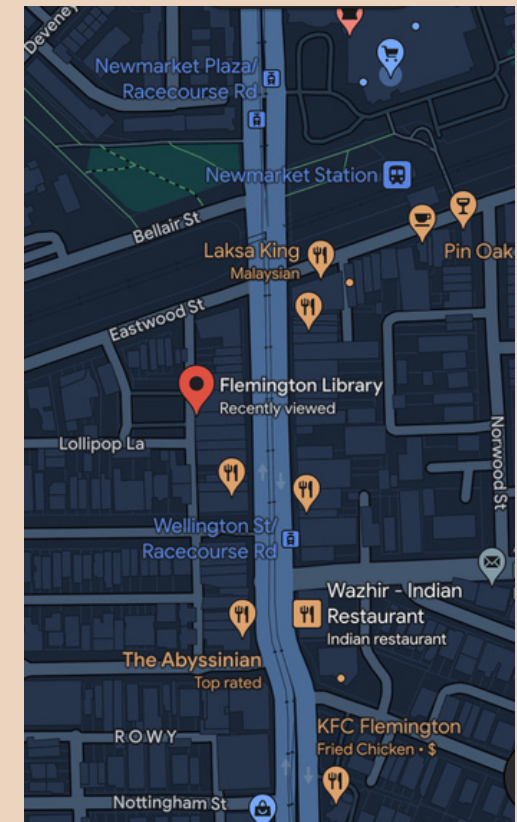

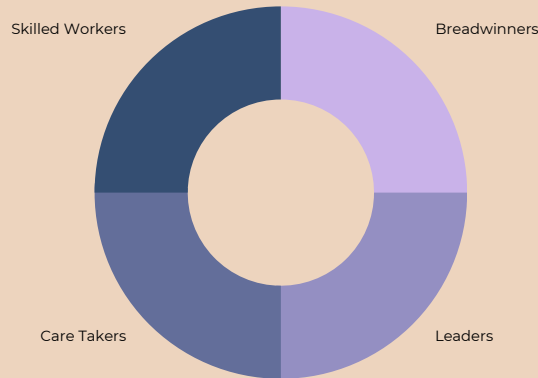
The **Empowering Women Seeking Asylum Initiative** was developed in recognition of Women Seeking Asylum as promising leaders in Australian society and future of work.
