






Old Quad is a museum that holds temporary exhibitions.

There will also be description signs beside each exhibit. I can read these to find out more about the exhibits.






Sometimes there are video and audio artworks that can be bright and loud.

Other times I might have to stand to look at the artworks.








There are hand dryers in the bathrooms at the Old Quad Gallery. The lights are very bright too.
