

UTR7.151 - JOYCE LAMBERT ANTARCTIC RESEARCH FUND

Recitals-

- A. Margaret Joyce Boyd Lambert, late of East Malvern in the State of Victoria, who died on 4 March 1984, bequeathed to the University one-tenth of her residuary estate "for the purpose of antarctic research".
- B. The University received \$29,371 in satisfaction of the bequest, which sum increased to \$64,219 at 31 December 1994.

It is provided as follows-

- 1. The sum of \$29,371 and any accumulations and additions to the sum forms a fund known as the "Joyce Lambert Antarctic Research Fund" ("the fund") and the fund must be paid into an investment pool and remain there until the Council directs otherwise.
- 2.
 - (1) The net income of the fund is applied to antarctic research by the Council on the recommendation of a committee determined from time to time by the Council.
 - (2) The Council may direct that the capital of the fund be resorted to for the purpose set out in (1).
