

# How to Use MFA while Overseas

## Pre-enrol



Pre-enrol your device on Okta Verify before travelling to avoid potential University application access issues.

## Set up a backup factor



After enrolling on Okta Verify, we recommend that you set up Google Authenticator as a backup factor.

## Think ahead



You will be prompted to verify while overseas, so please always keep your device handy to avoid delays.

## Time and Date Settings



Ensure that the time and date on your enrolled device match those of your location.

## Enrol from overseas



You can follow the normal enrolment process and scan the Okta QR code on your smartphone when overseas.



## Please be aware:

MFA may prompt you at any time to confirm it's really you logging in.
