

UTR7.191 - JOHN HARVEY FOSTER BEQUEST

Recitals-

- A. John Harvey Foster, a former lecturer in History at the University, late of Flat 4, 171 Howard Street, North Melbourne, who died on 6 May 1994, bequeathed to the University nine-tenths of his residuary estate 'for the purpose of increasing the Research Collections in the fields of Modern Jewish History and Modern German History.'
- B. The University has received the sum of \$468,000 in satisfaction of the bequest.

It is provided as follows-

- 1. The sum of \$468,000 and any accumulations or additions to the sum forms a fund known as the 'John Harvey Foster Bequest' ('the fund') and must be paid into an investment pool and remain there until the Council directs otherwise.
- 2. The net annual income of the fund may be applied by the Council on the recommendation of the head of the department of History to increasing the Research Collection in the fields of Modern Jewish History and Modern German History.
- 3. The Council may on the recommendation of the head of the department of History direct that the capital of the fund be resorted to for the purpose stated above.
