

## **UTR7.169 - SIR RANDAL HEYMANSON FOUNDATION**

### **Recitals-**

- A. Sir Randal Heymanson, late of 7 Mitchell Place, New York, in the United States of America, bequeathed to "the School of Medicine of the University of Melbourne" part of his Australian residuary estate with the direction that the income from the bequest "be devoted each year to research into the prevention and alleviation of physical pain on the recommendation of the Dean of the School".
- B. The University received \$480,787 in satisfaction of the bequest, which sum increased to \$920,787 at 31 December 1994.

It is provided as follows-

- 1. The sum of \$920,787 and any accumulations or additions to the sum forms a fund called the "Sir Randal Heymanson Foundation Fund" ("the fund") and the fund must be paid into an investment pool and remain there until the Council directs otherwise.
- 2. The net annual income of the fund is applied by the Council to medical research directed towards the prevention and alleviation of physical pain on the recommendation of the dean of the faculty of Medicine, Dentistry and Health Sciences ('the dean').
- 3. In making recommendations the dean must consult with a committee of which he or she must be a member and which must also include the vice-chancellor and five other persons appointed by the Council from time to time on the recommendation of the vice-chancellor.
