

UTR 7.320 – THE ISAAC SCHWEITZER TRAVELLING FELLOWSHIP

Background

- A. Following an appeal to friends and colleagues of Professor Isaac Schweitzer, the University raised \$50,000 (**Fund**) to establish, in perpetuity, The Isaac Schweitzer Travelling Fellowship (**Fellowship**). The Fund includes a pledge of \$12,500 from Healthscope Melbourne Clinic.
- B. The Fellowship is an annual fellowship for “an early career researcher or psychiatrist, providing the opportunity to travel overseas to undergo training or professional development to further their career in the field of psychiatry” (Purpose).
- C. Affectionately known by all as ‘Issy’, Professor Schweitzer graduated in medicine from the University in 1973, completing his diploma in psychological medicine in 1978, and trained in psychiatry at the Royal Melbourne Hospital and the Parkville Psychiatric Unit. As a young psychiatrist, Professor Schweitzer chose to continue his training at St Thomas’ Hospital in London and then as a Consultation Liaison Psychiatry Fellow at Montefiore Medical Centre, Albert Einstein College of Medicine, New York. Returning to Melbourne, Professor Schweitzer went on to establish and head the research unit at The Melbourne Clinic.
- D. This University Trust Record is the means by which the University records –
 - (1) the trusts upon which the University holds trust property, including the capital sum; and
 - (2) the administrative arrangements for the implementation and ongoing performance of those trusts from time to time.

The trust terms and administrative arrangements governing the Fund are as follows.

Trust terms

1. A perpetual trust was established for the Purpose on receipt by the University of the Fund and the University is the trustee of that trust.
2. The University must invest and preserve the Fund and any accumulations and additions to the Fund and apply the net income arising from the Fund to support the Purpose.
3. Any unexpended income may be retained as income and be available in any subsequent year to be applied for the Purpose.

Administrative arrangements

In order to implement the trust terms, the University has determined that:

1. the Dean of the Faculty of Medicine, Dentistry and Health Services (or its successor) is authorised by the University to award the Fellowship on behalf of the University.
